### **BE IT:**

Make some cards to give to those who give to us. Show some respect to fire fighters, police officers, hospital staff members, anyone! Make a handful of cards and keep them with you to hand out all month.

RESPECT // WOLF // ORANGE

## Day 1:

The Big Idea this month is respect. Respect is showing others they are important by what you say and do. The animal that represents respect is the wolf and our color for the month is orange. We will be learning about respect all month. Since respect is showing others they are important by what you say and do, we will be paying special attention to our words and actions this month.

## Day 2:

The Big Idea this month is respect. Respect is showing others they are important by what you say and do. Our color this month is orange. Orange is used often in our world to help us notice things, like traffic cones or barrels that show that road work is being done. The color orange is used by hunters, joggers and bicyclists so they may be seen by others. Think about how the color orange can remind us to show respect for others and keep them safe.

## Day 3:

The Big Idea this month is respect. Respect is showing others they are important by what you say and do. Our animal this month is the wolf. Wolves are born blind but within 2 weeks, their eyes are open and they are learning from their parents. They travel in packs and are found on every continent in the world. They are carnivores or meat eaters and are excellent hunters. They are respected by other animals who show their respect by staying out of their way.

## Day 4:

The Big Idea this month is respect. Respect is showing others they are important by what you say and do. We have been talking about value words this year, called Big Ideas. Each month we have talked about a Big Idea, learned about it, looked for it in others and then practiced living it out ourselves. What would our school look and sound like if we were all respectful?

## Day 5:

The Big Idea this month is respect. Respect is showing others they are important by what you say and do. Respect is shown in many ways every day throughout our country. Standing for the pledge and the National Anthem are two ways we show our respect for our country

### Day 6:

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The Big Idea this month is respect. Respect is showing others they are important by what you say and do. Have you ever heard the expression “taking the high road”? Talk about that with your teacher today and how “taking the high road” is an act of respect.

### Day 7:

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The Big Idea this month is respect. Respect is showing others they are important by what you say and do. Dave Willis once said, “Show respect even to people who don’t deserve it; not as a reflection of their character, but as a reflection of yours.” What do you think this means?

### Day 8:

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The Big Idea this month is respect. Respect is showing others they are important by what you say and do. Have you ever noticed that you get hungry when you see something orange? Orange is a color that stimulates the appetite. Do you think the walls in a restaurant might be painted orange so you’ll buy more food? If so, choose to respect your body by selecting foods that are healthy from the menu and not overeating.

### Day 9:

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The Big Idea this month is respect. Respect is showing others they are important by what you say and do. Wolves are members of the dog family and can weigh as much as 175 pounds. They have been known to live up to 16 years in captivity, but the average lifespan in the wild is 6 to 8 years. Life in the wild can be hard, but the wolf is one of the most effective predators, gaining the respect of other animals in the wild.

### Day 10:

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The Big Idea this month is respect. Respect is showing others they are important by what you say and do. One way to show respect is to obey laws and rules in our school or in society. When cars pull over to let an ambulance or police car go by, the driver is showing respect for the work done by policemen and emergency workers. Think about rules or essential agreements in our school—do any of them mention respect?

### Day 11:

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The Big Idea this month is respect. Respect is showing others they are important by what you say and do. Did you know that you can have respect for yourself? Self-respect comes from making good decisions and taking a stand for your beliefs.

### Day 12:

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The Big Idea this month is respect. Respect is showing others they are important by what you say and do. A group of wolves is called a pack. Each pack has a leader. The wolf pack shows respect to the wolf leader by their actions, just as humans show respect to their leaders by what they say and do.

### Day 13:

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The Big Idea this month is respect. Respect is showing others they are important by what you say and do. When we go to certain places, we have to act different ways. Some places like ballgames are a great place to yell and whistle and make lots of noise. However, other places require that we show respect with silence or quiet voices, like museums and libraries. It is important to be able to change your behavior to fit the situation. If you’re not sure, look to an adult who is modeling the proper respect.

### Day 14:

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The Big Idea this month is respect. Respect is showing others they are important by what you say and do. Think about the Big 3: treating others right, making smart decisions and maximizing your potential. How does treating others right relate to respect?

### Day 15:

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The Big Idea this month is respect. Respect is showing others they are important by what you say and do. Dogs and wolves have several behaviors in common. One is shaking after being wet. The wolf’s undercoat is important so the wolf can stay warm. Too much water and dirt can make the fur lose its insulating qualities. The shaking keeps the wolf’s body dry and clean. Think of all the ways you keep yourself clean. You are showing respect to yourself and others when you take good care of your body.

### Day 16:

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The Big Idea this month is respect. Respect is showing others they are important by what you say and do. The great baseball player Jackie Robinson once said, "I'm not concerned with your liking or disliking me... All I ask is that you respect me as a human being." What do you think he meant by that? Do you think sometimes people treat people differently because of the color of their skin or their cultural differences?

### Day 17:

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The Big Idea this month is respect. Respect is showing others they are important by what you say and do. Can you think of any orange foods? How about cantaloupes, pumpkins, sweet potatoes, oranges, and some types of tomatoes? They are all healthy and good for you. Orange is a color that is used to make signs that keep us safe and healthy on the road too, like "Men at Work" and "Lane Closed-Detour Ahead." Highway employees use orange paint to mark roads so that they will dig in the right places. Orange is a helpful, respectful color!

### Day 18:

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The Big Idea this month is respect. Respect is showing others they are important by what you say and do. Think about the Big 3: treating others right, making smart decisions and maximizing your potential. How is using respect making a right decision?

### Day 19:

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The Big Idea this month is respect. Respect is showing others they are important by what you say and do. Kids don't only need to show respect to adults in their lives. Kids need to show respect for other kids. Sometimes you might not agree with another kid about a topic, but you can show respect by listening to their point of view. It is important for members of a community to agree to disagree and do so respectfully.

### Day 20:

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The Big Idea this month is respect. Respect is showing others they are important by what you say and do. This month we've talked about respect, the color orange and wolves. You probably have noticed respect among your friends and the adults in our school all month long by listening and watching. Being a respectful person is a life-long process.

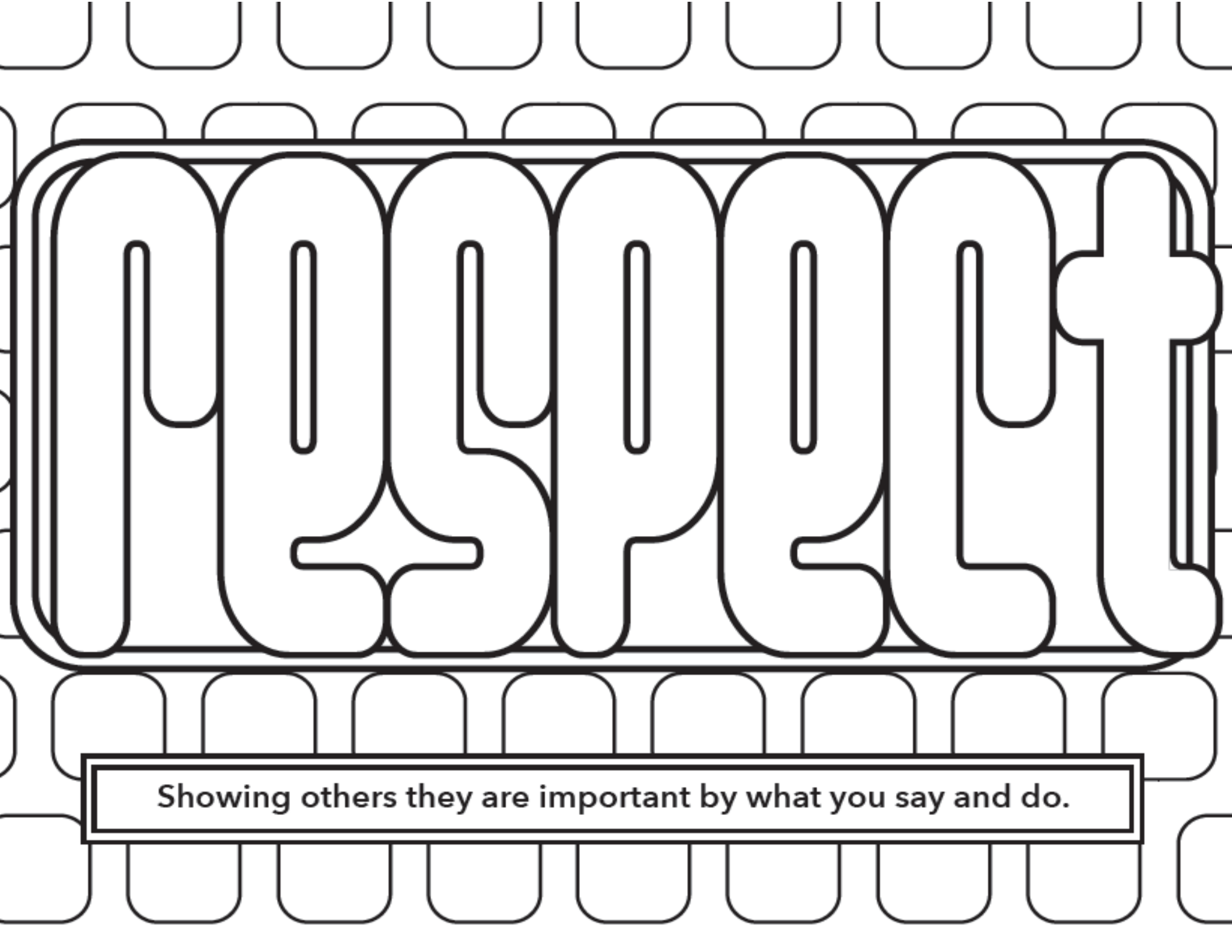
## Core Essential Values

You may be taller

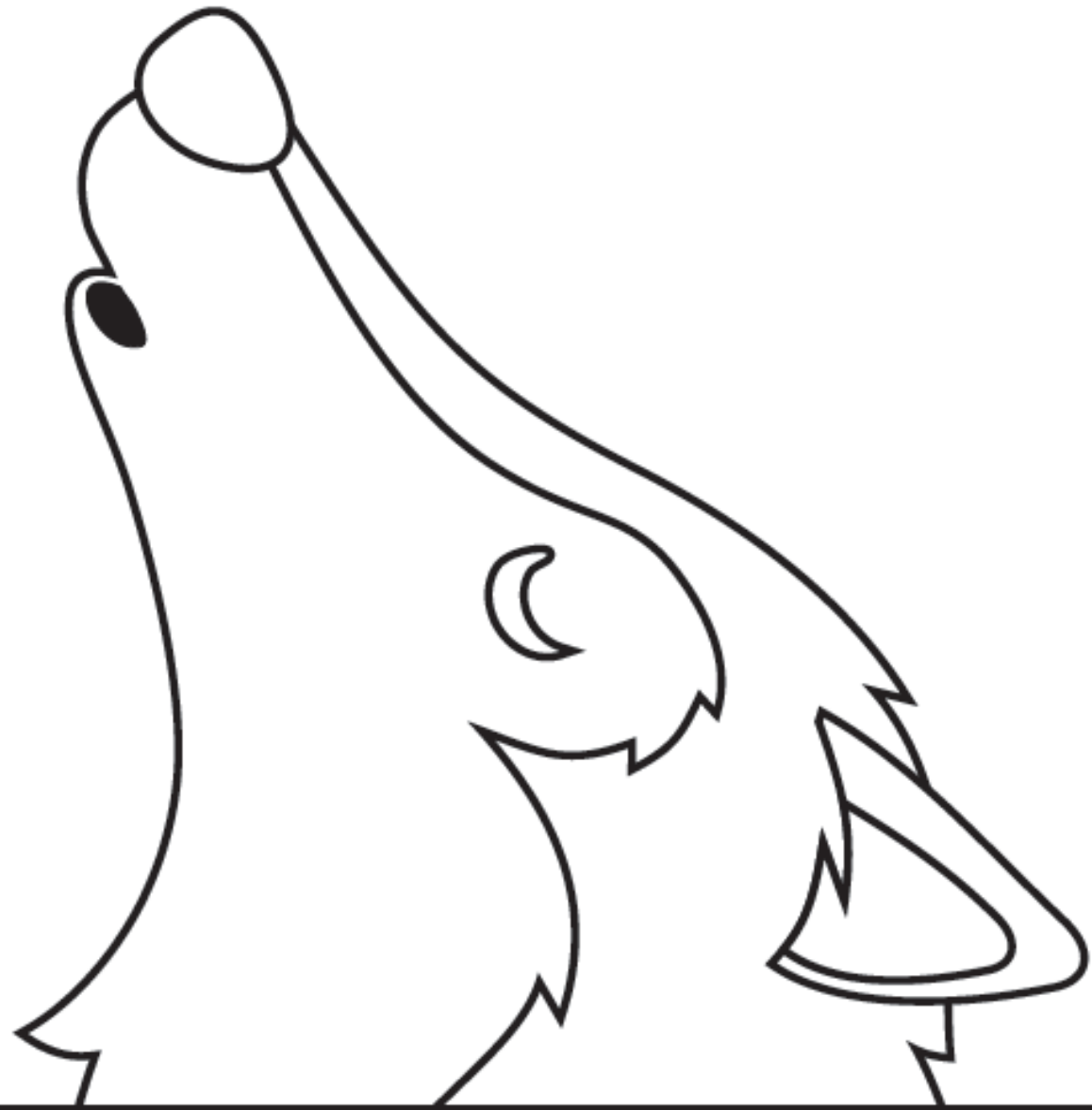
But you've got to show a little respect
